HazMat Medic Course

The National Fire Protection Association recommends all ALS EMS personnel at a hazardous materials incident shall be trained to meet at least the competencies of the operations level responder in NFPA 472 and chapter five of NFPA 473. This course address many of those requirements found in NFPA 473.

The goal of this course is to provide the ALS-certified individual with the knowledge and skills necessary to safely deliver ALS at hazardous materials / weapons of mass destruction incidents. Topics include:

- Analyzing a hazardous materials incident to determine the potential health risks to the ALS provider, other responders, and anticipated patients.
- Identifying chemical and physical properties that can affect patient exposure outcome, and
- Developing and implementing a pre-hospital treatment plan for exposed patients based on multiple toxidromes.

This course is provided by Emergency Operational Solutions. The lead instructor is Michael Schultz who is a firefighter, hazmat technician, paramedic, and instructor with over 20 years of experience as a hazmat medic. Visit <u>eosolutions.us</u> for more information.
