

## HazMat Medic Course

Monday, December 5<sup>th</sup>, 2022 (8:30 a.m. - 12:00 noon)

The National Fire Protection Association recommends all EMS personnel at a hazardous materials incident to be trained to meet Chapter 46 (BLS) and Chapter 47 (ALS) of NFPA 470, in addition to traditional Hazmat Operations training. This course serves as an introduction to those requirements in NFPA 470 chapters 46 and 47.

The goal of this course is to provide the ALS-licensed individual with the knowledge and skills necessary to safely deliver ALS at a hazardous materials / weapons of mass destruction incident. Topics include:

- Analyzing a hazardous materials incident to determine the potential health risks to the BLS and ALS providers, other responders, and anticipated patients.
- Identifying chemical and physical properties that can affect patient exposure outcome.
- Developing and implementing a prehospital treatment plan for exposed patients based on multiple toxidromes.

This course is free and there are no prerequisites to attend, however, the most benefit will be obtained by students with ALS-level licensure and having completed at least an Operations-Level Hazardous Materials Incident Response course.
