

COVID case counts across the country and in Missouri continue to rise at a pretty steady rate.




EMS Call volume is actually decreasing. Now at about 77% of the 2019 averages.



Call severity is also decreasing just a bit. Now at about 72% of the 2019 averages.



We set a goal to reduce labor hours by 25% to offset these reductions in revenue. Since implementation (8 days ago), we have averaged a 19% reduction.
