




Not much new. Everyone is still plugging away. Places are opening up and we aren't seeing a spike in illnesses in regard to ambulance calls, though.

Local data stuff:


- Call volume since 3/15/20 is **83.6%** of what it was in 2019.
 - o Last week we were at **158** with a goal of 185 calls per week before we resume normal shift scheduling.
- Transport volume since 3/15/20 is **79.7%** of what it was in 2019.
- ALS transport volume since 3/15/20 is **72.6%** of what it was in 2019.
- Our response to these drops has been:
 - \circ Hours worked since 4/26/20 is **84.0%** of what it was in 2019.
 - Overtime hours worked since 4/26/20 is 28.0% of what it was in 2019. Wow! Good job.
