


Here's the data you have all grown to love:


We are almost back up to the highest new cases per week in Missouri since before lifting the quarantine. Please remain vigilant with protecting yourself from symptomatic patients (masks on both the patient and staff). Also, limit aerosolizing treatments for symptomatic patients. Pay special attention as you are working in facilities with compromised and vulnerable patients (i.e. LTC).



Call volume in the last four weeks was 97% of what it was before 3/15/20.


The current goal to return to 12-hour shifts in Bolivar is above 185 calls for three weeks in a row, service-wide. Last week saw the second-highest call volume in the past 12 months. If next week is that high again, we might recommend returning to all 12-hour shifts.





Overtime in the past four weeks was 58% of what we had before 4/19/20.

The goal is to remain below 11%. In the last four weeks, we averaged <u>10%</u>.
