 we start having to quarantine staff and reduce ambulance coverage. Review the new policy

- Clarification from infection control also happened today for pre-hospital questions. If an employee
 tests positive for COVID, they cannot return to work until they are symptom-free for five days
 AND greater than ten days since onset of symptoms AND greater than ten days since the positive
 test. When the employee returns, there are no greater restrictions that what all employees currently
 have.

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
